

NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 57

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 57 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, April 22, 2024, at 9:00 a.m.** at the Pine Mill Ranch Community Center, 28610 Pine Mill Ranch Drive, Katy, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, and amend the budget.
4. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
5. Operator's report on operation, maintenance, and repair of District water, sanitary sewer, storm water facilities, customer billing and collection, and maintenance and repair proposals, including the following:
 - a. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service;
 - b. Water Provider Conservation Program;
 - c. review of District facilities;
 - d. North Fort Bend Water Authority report;
 - e. automated meter reading replacement; and
 - f. conduct annual review and receive report from operator on Identity Theft Prevention Program and adopt Identity Theft Prevention Program Amendment.
6. Engineering matters, including preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, Pay Estimates and Change Orders, and acceptance of projects, if appropriate, for the following:
 - a. five-year capital improvements plan;
 - b. FM 1463 expansion project;
 - c. second emergency interconnect with Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 58;
 - d. Geographic Information System;
 - e. Water Plant No. 2;
 - f. update on KCF remote monitoring of facilities;
 - g. Pine Mill Ranch and Avalon at Pine Mill outfalls; and
 - h. Wastewater Treatment Plant rehabilitation.
7. Authorize acceptance and/or conveyance of deeds, easements, and consents to encroachment, abandonment of easements, and right-of-way entry request.
8. Review and approve report on electricity consumption and energy efficiency measures and take any necessary action.
9. Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Phase II Small MS4 General Permit.

10. Detention pond and landscaping maintenance and repairs report(s) and proposals, including:
 - a. approve Amendment to Service Agreement with First Environment Erosion Controls, Inc.; and
 - b. update regarding fence repairs and replacements.
11. Update on District's website, including text alert process.
12. Attorney's report.
13. Meeting schedule.
